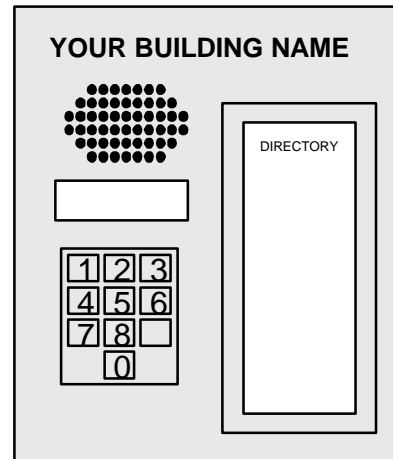
DESCRIPTION:

The HDI 1020 telephone entry system is a self-contained commercial and residential building intercom system. Installation is simple and low cost. It is accomplished by connecting a standard 2-wire telephone line and 16VAC to the unit, connecting the door strike and programming the unit.

MOUNTING SYSTEMS & DIMENSIONS

Specify either surface (standard) or flush mounting (consult Mfg.). Flush mounting is accomplished using a back box; surface mounting uses factory supplied brackets.

The HDI 1020™ is designed to work with existing residential or commercial building telephone systems, and access control components including card readers, proximity chips, CCTV, etc.

SYSTEM OPERATION:

Building guests gain access by entering the tenant's unit 4-digit code (listed on the directory) via the telephone keypad buttons on the lobby panel. This action will ring the tenant's telephone, notifying the tenant that a guest wishes entry.

Two-way communications between the tenant and guest is established when the tenant picks up the apartment telephone handset.

Building entry is accomplished then the tenant presses the "9" on their telephone, activating of the lobby door strike permitting guest access to the building for 5 to 10 seconds.
